THE 5-MINUTE PARENT CHECK

Open the chatbot's settings with your child and review these five areas.

1

Set the right account

Confirm the service allows your child's age. Use built-in supervision when available.

2

Turn off model training

Look for "Improve the model," "Model training," or "AI data retention."

3

Limit what AI remembers

Review memory, personalization, history, and saved activity. Delete old chats.

4

Check permissions

Disable unneeded location, camera, mic, contacts, connected apps, and file access.

5

Make one clear family rule

Never enter: passwords, home address, school ID, medical or financial details, private photos, or documents you would not post publicly.
